

New developments in community based learning disability Support.



Boston Avenue, The first of Field Lane's community supported houses for people with learning disabilities, will have been joined by 3 similar projects by April 2010

Finally, the major elements of Field Lane's £1.6million grants and loans investment package from the Government's capacity building agency, Futurebuilders, are being realised.

Building and development completion dates have now been signed for Ailsa Road, Southend, Essex (12/02/10) and Westmead Drive in Salfords, Surrey (02/04/10). These two houses will eventually support a further 12 people with learning disabilities to live full and more independent lives in the wider community.

They will join the expanding number of people receiving care and support from the Field Lane Care and Support Agency. Field Lane has also taken over the management and will provide support for the four tenants with learning disabilities, at Court Lodge, Caterham in Surrey.

The development of the registered care agency, Field Lane Care and Support, is a key objective in Field Lane's business plan. With a greater emphasis being put on the 'personalisation agenda' for community care, Field Lane hopes to increase the agency's capacity to deliver high quality services to those in need.
