Today, from our Christian heritage and as a registered charity and housing association, we provide care, accommodation and support to; older people living with dementia, independent older people, adults with learning disabilities and families and children who are homeless. With quality of life as our principle, our care and support is flexibly structured to respectfully preserve dignity and individuality while promoting choice and independence. Our services are consistently well regarded by the Care Commission and local authorities.

Services for older people



Our two specialist care and nursing homes welcome older people living with dementia. Dovers in Reigate and The Priory in West Worthing are long established and demonstrate our positive approach to living with dementia. Our services promote choice, opportunity and independence; each person has a personalised care plan that guides their individual support. Respite care and short trial stays are also available as well as stimulating day care.

We also have 19 affordable flats in the grounds of our Dovers home in Reigate for older people with more independent lifestyles.

Learning Disabilities



Field Lane's care and support promotes independence and real choice. Since 1993, our 'Badgers' home in Rayleigh, Essex, has provided residential nursing and support for people with high level needs.

Our supported housing projects in Essex and Surrey benefit from intensive support from the Field Lane Care and Support Agency which helps our tenants to enjoy their lives in the wider community. We also offer support to tenants of other organisations and run popular weekly social clubs.

Homeless Families



Family support with a family focus

Homeless families come from a wide variety of backgrounds and with diverse needs. Field Lane helps families to break the cycle of homelessness through accommodation and structured individualised support. In house activities include workshops on parenting and relationship skills, childcare, healthy lifestyles and nutrition awareness and families are supported to access welfare, education, health, religious and local amenity services.

Management Services

Our management services can be fully outsourced, or delivered in house with our support. Our modern central services and wide knowledge and experience of care management mean that we successfully manage care services and provide training for other charities.
