Why Field Lane?

Field Lane is committed to promoting the benefits of good training across organisations with widely varying needs.

We offer training in five locations throughout London and the South East. These include a dedicated training suite at our care home in Reigate and two training centres conveniently situated in central London.

In addition, Field Lane can offer 'in house' training tailored to meet the specific needs of a wide range of different companies and organisations.

Field Lane training courses lead to recognised qualifications.

Depending on the course, students will receive a certificate awarded by the Chartered Institute of Environmental Health, a Field Lane Certificate of Attendance or a qualification approved by the Association of First Aiders. All Field Lane courses are acceptable to CSCI.

In 2007, staff who had completed a Field Lane first aid course used their knowledge to save a life. Paramedics confirmed that, without their intervention, the person would have died.
